

1. OBJECTIVES

The Objectives of MOU are

- i) To promote and enhance academic interests between PGPCAS and SVMC
- ii) To exchange ideas for the implementation of Quality education between the Colleges
- iii) To promote research activities between the Colleges.

2. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION

- i) To improve the quality of teaching staff through Short/Long term certificate courses
- ii) To facilitate the training for Faculty and Students of both the Colleges within the area of co-operation.
- iii) To formulate syllabi for academic programmes, new courses, joint research projects and training for skill oriented Human Resources with due approval of both the Colleges and within the framework of rules and regulation governing both the Colleges
- iv) To arrange Training programs, Diploma programs, Certification programs and Value Added courses for Faculty and Students of both the Colleges within the area of co-operation
- v) To conduct, whenever feasible, national events, Joint workshops, conferences, training programs within the areas of mutual interest
- vi) To encourage the faculty/technical personnel to deliver lectures/invited talks in the other Colleges
- vii) To share and utilize equipments, facilities, hardware, software and other materials & components in the area of co-operation if advisable within the framed rules governing both the Colleges
- viii) To access laboratory, library and other supporting facilities
- ix) Joint supervision of PG, M.Phil and Ph,D Thesis

3. MODES OF COLLABORATION

- i) Cooperation and promotion of education and training in the area of mutual interest
- ii) The areas of co-operation will be defined and modified from time to time by the co-operation committee set up for the purpose
- iii) A specific agreement will be entered into for each activity

4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i) Both the Colleges agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and research students from other colleges to participate in Conferences, Workshops and Training programmes



- ii) Travel and other expenses of Faculty and research students should be borne by respective Colleges
- iii) The MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the colleges at any time.
- iv) Either College has the right to terminate this MOU 90 days prior written notice to the other College

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

- i) Both the Colleges (PGPCAS and SVMC) agree not to disclose confidential information/data (created during the performance of MOU) to any third party without written consent of the other College

6. DURATION OF MOU

- i) This MOU will expire in FOUR years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, upon review, the MOU shall be extended for another ONE year by mutual consent.

7. COORDINATORS

- i) For Co-ordination and implementation of the agreement the persons will be designated by both the Colleges

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS


- i) The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that emerge as a results of collaborative activity under this agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with IPR policies of the respective colleges

9. SIGNED COPIES (DUPLICATE)

- i) This MOU is signed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity
- ii) This MOU is signed below by the duly authorized officers of the both colleges. This MOU to be executed, is effective as of the day and year as mentioned above.
